

New Mexico State Canvassing Board Order for Automatic Recount

2023 Regular Local Election

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, Section 1-14-24(A)(3) provides that an automatic recount of the vote is required when the canvass of returns for an election in certain offices indicates that the margin between the two candidates receiving the greatest number of votes for the office is one percent of the total votes cast for that office in that election or five or fewer votes; and

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, Section 1-14-24(A)(2) provides that an automatic recount of the vote is required when the canvass of returns for in the case of a local ballot question indicates that the margin between those supporting and those opposing a ballot question is one-half percent; and

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, November 28, 2023, the Office of the New Mexico Secretary of State notified the New Mexico State Canvassing Board that based upon the results of the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, an automatic recount is required for thirty-seven local races and 1 public school capital improvement tax question.

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for Councilor At-Large, City of Lordsburg, between Krystal Dawn Kennedy and Irene A Galvan, resulted in a margin of 0.52 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for Commission District 3, City of Ratón, between Ronald D Chavez and Mark L Honeyfield, resulted in a margin of 0.07 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for Councilor At-Large, City of Rio Communities, between Thomas W Nelson and Jimmie Dale Winters, resulted in a margin of 0.00 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for Councilor At-Large, City of Socorro, between Gordon E Gordy Hicks and W Nicholas Fleming, resulted in a margin of 0.48 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for City Commissioner, City of Truth or Consequences, between Chaz M Glines and Amanda L

Forrister, resulted in a margin of 0.74 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for Trustee At-Large, Town of Carrizozo, between Edward Lee Obrien and Damien E Luna, resulted in a margin of 0.16 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for Councilor At-Large, Town of Lake Arthur, between John Robert Teel and Harry Lewis Wesson, resulted in a margin of 0.73 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for Trustee At-Large, Town of Springer, between Gerald C Duran and Luella Smith, resulted in a margin of four votes, which is fewer than five votes for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for Councilor At-Large, Town of Taos, between Billy Romero and Darien D Fernandez, resulted in a margin of 0.88 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for Councilor At-Large, Village of Angel Fire, between Owen Sullivan Curry and James Jacob Crain, resulted in a margin of 0.14 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for Trustee, Village of Columbus, between Wilson Edward Moore and William Dean Johnson, resulted in a margin of 0.88 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for Mayor, Village of Grady, between Kodie D Weese and James Carroll Schell, resulted in a margin of three votes, which is fewer than five votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for Councilor At-Large, Village of Grady, between James M Austin and Bobby Gene Windham, resulted in a margin of one vote, which is fewer than five votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for Councilor At-Large, Village of Logan, between Wesley Brian Cox and Deanna K Osborn, resulted

in a margin of 0.21 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for Trustee At-Large, Village of Magdalena, between Michael Craig Thompson and Harvan Karen Conrad, resulted in a margin of 0.33 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for Councilor At-Large, Village of Reserve, between Bradley Joseph Proper and Debbie A Lee, resulted in a margin of four votes, which is fewer than five votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for Trustee, Village of Williamsburg, between Lee R Wedgwood Jr and Cathy A Luenenborg, resulted in a margin of five votes, which is equal to five votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for School Board Member At-Large, Capitan School District, between Craig J Westbrook and Weston E Hacker, resulted in a margin of 0.04 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for School Board Member At-Large, Carrizozo School District, between Holly M Marron and John W Serna, resulted in a margin of 0.89 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election for School Board Member District 2, Central Consolidated Educational District, between Hoskie Benally Jr and Gary J Montoya, resulted in a margin of 0.28 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for School Board Member At-Large, Cloudcroft School District, between Cassandra Gail Saffle and Jeffrey Grant Eigenmann, resulted in a margin of 0.19 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for School Board Member At-Large, Dexter School District, between Vanessa D Sanders and James Salas, resulted in a margin of four votes, which is fewer than five votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for School Board Member At-Large, Floyd School District, between Marvin Leon Nall and Delbert M Rector, resulted in a margin of 0.99 percent, which equals one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for School Board Member At-Large, Hatch Valley School District, between Lupe M Castillo Reynaldo Gonzalez, resulted in a margin of 0.78 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for School Board Member At-Large, Hondo School District, between Brandon S Devine and Irene P Sanchez, resulted in a margin of 0.94 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023 Regular Local Election, for School Board Member At-Large, Jal Municipal School District, between Jenny Leigh Edwards and Randy P Chavez, resulted in a margin of 0.63 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for School Board Member District 5, Las Cruces Public School District, between Carol Lynn Cooper and Edward Frank, resulted in a margin of 0.75 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for School Board Member At-Large, Lordsburg School District, between Alfredo (Freddy) Morelos Jr and Fabian P De La O, resulted in a margin of 0.66 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for School Board Member At-Large, Magdalena School District, between Kelly L Kern and Sharon L Harris, resulted in a margin of 0.73 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for School Board Member, Ratón School District, between Kathleen M Honeyfield and Dustin James Walton, resulted in a margin of 0.30 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for School Board Member At-Large, San Jon School District, between Brian Michael Watson and Leslie Dale Bone, resulted in a margin of five votes, which is equal to five votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for School Board Member At-Large, Tularosa School District, between Erica L Walters and Megan G Cairns, resulted in a margin of 0.86 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for School Board Member At-Large, Vaughn Municipal School District, between Maria Antonia Sanchez and Rudy R Martinez, resulted in a margin of two votes, which is fewer than five votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for College Board Member District 5, San Juan College District, between Judy M Hale and Beverly D Taylor, resulted in a margin of 0.25 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for Soil and Water Supervisor (Landowner), East Rio Arriba Soil and Water Conservation District, between Edward F Martinez and Ronald K Martinez, resulted in a margin of 0.33 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election for Soil and Water Supervisor, Tierra y Montes Soil and Water Conservation District, Martin B Honegger and Drew Linden Hager, resulted in a margin of 0.99 percent, which is equal to one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for Soil and Water Supervisor, Valencia Soil and Water Conservation District, between David L Neff and James Robert Fischer, resulted in a margin of 0.31 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 7, 2023, Regular Local Election, for the Capital Improvement Tax Question, Aztec Public School District, resulted in a margin of 0.29 percent, which is less than half of one percent of the total votes cast for that question; and

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, November 28, 2023, the Secretary of State, pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 1-14-24(B), properly notified the New Mexico State Canvassing Board that, based upon the results of the November 7, 2023 Regular Local Election, an automatic recount is required for Councilor At-Large, City of Lordsburg; Commission District 3, City of Ratón; Councilor At-Large, City of Rio Communities; Councilor At-Large, City of Socorro; City Commissioner, City of Truth or Consequences; Trustee At-Large, Town of Carrizozo; Councilor At-Large, Town of Lake Arthur; Trustee At-Large, Town of Springer; Councilor At-Large, Town of Taos; Councilor At-Large, Village of Angel Fire; Trustee, Village of Columbus; Mayor, Village of Grady; Councilor At-Large, Village of Grady; Councilor At-Large, Village of Logan; Trustee At-Large,
